

CORPORATE MEMBER Benefits Checklist

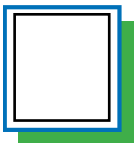

If the information you want to use on the member page is different from what you submitted, please send it to info@bacnetinternational.org.

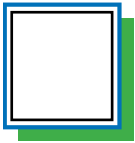


Have your employees/co-workers subscribe to our email distribution list.

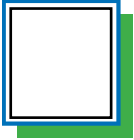
